Zion Methodist Church is seeking to recruit a Neighbourhood Worker to start in September 2025. The closing date for applications is Friday 6 June at 5pm and interviews will be held in person on Friday 20 June.

The role will be based at Zion for 20 hours per week, worked flexibly. Pay will be £15.60 per hour (the Methodist Church is a Living Wage employer).
