Child Poverty: Faith leaders call for decisive action

Thirty-eight senior faith leaders from the five major faith groups represented in the UK have written to the Prime Minister and Chancellor, urging them to "act now to secure the futures of millions of children."

"It's simply wrong that so many children are growing up without the essentials of life. This is a cry for change, rooted in our belief that change is possible. Rising levels of child poverty are not inevitable. The government's pledge to lift children out of poverty during this parliament is welcome, but now it needs to be backed up with real commitments, including scrapping the two-child limit on benefits."
