But while we affirm each other as God's precious gifts, please let's not lose any opportunity to speak of God's indescribable gift to us in Jesus. God's very own self, given freely in human form, loving us with the costliest love imaginable that took him through death and beyond, rising to prove that the impossible can be made possible. For those searching or stuck, it could be life-changing for their minds, hands and hearts to unlock and accept the Saving Grace of God-in-Jesus; just to take a risk on Christian faith this Christmas and see if it makes a difference.
